ORDER APPROVING A LIMITED AGENT REGISTRATION

This Order is entered pursuant to the Arkansas Securities Act, codified at Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-42-101 through 23-42-509 (“Act”), the Rules of the Arkansas Securities Commissioner (“Rules”) promulgated under the Act, and the Arkansas Administrative Procedures Act, codified at Ark. Code Ann. §§ 25-15-201 through 25-15-219.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about June 5, 2019, Joshua Matthew Brock (“Brock”) submitted an application to become a registered agent of the issuer for the Christian Financial Resources, Inc. (“Christian Financial”).
2. Brock, as an officer and employee of Christian Financial, petitioned the Arkansas Securities Commissioner (“Commissioner”) to waive the Securities Industry Essentials (SIE) examination and the appropriate general knowledge or Series 7 examination requirements for his registration as an agent of Christian Financial. Brock executed an affidavit attesting to the facts in this Order attached hereto as Exhibit A.
3. Brock passed the Series 63 examination on August 1, 2018.
4. Christian Financial, is a charitable organization pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

5. Brock, as an officer and employee of Christian Financial, performs significant functions for Christian Financial other than effecting or attempting to effect the sale of securities.

6. Brock represents only Christian Financial in effecting or attempting to effect sales of securities and will offer and sell only securities issued by Christian Financial.

7. Brock will receive no compensation or similar remuneration either directly or indirectly in connection with the offer and sale of Christian Financial securities.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-42-302(a)(2), the Commissioner may approve a limited registration with such limitations, qualifications, or conditions as the Commissioner deems appropriate.

9. In order to be registered as an agent, Rule 302.01(c)(1) of the Rules requires an agent of the issuer to pass the SIE exam, the appropriate general knowledge examination and the appropriate state law examination.

10. Pursuant to Rule 302.01(c)(6) of the Rules, the Commissioner may waive any or all of the examination requirements required for registration of an agent of the issuer based upon the limited time, amount, or nature of the issue or transaction involved.

11. Based upon the representations made by Brock, it is appropriate to waive the SIE and the appropriate general knowledge or Series 7 examination requirements and approve a limited registration as agent of the issuer.

ORDER

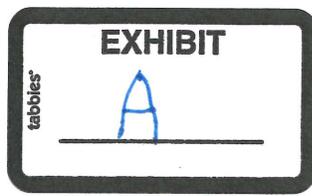
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of Brock for registration as an agent of Christian Financial, is hereby approved as a limited registration provided that

Brock only represent Christian Financial in effecting or attempting to effect sales of securities and that he is not and will not be compensated in connection with the offer and sale of Christian Financial's securities by the payment of commissions or other remuneration that is based on transactions in securities. The limited registration is effective until December 31, 2019, unless properly renewed.

AFFIDAVIT

7. I will receive no commissions or similar remuneration either directly or indirectly in connection with the offer and sale of CFR securities.

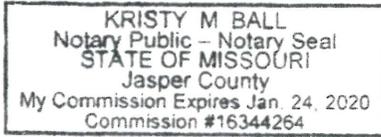
