ORDER

On April 24, 2013, this cause came on to be heard on Plaintiff's Complaint for *Ex Parte* Temporary Restraining Order and Other Relief filed herein on April 18, 2013, and on the Temporary Restraining Order entered by the Court on April 19, 2013, and with the Plaintiff being represented at open court hearing by J. Campbell McLaurin III, Staff Attorney for the Arkansas Securities Department, and the Defendants being represented by Peter G. Kumpe, attorney with the law firm of Williams & Anderson PLC, and the parties having reached an agreement on the issues, and the Court having heard and considered the same, and having jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter, finds the following, to-wit:

1. The terms and provisions contained in the Temporary Restraining Order entered in this cause on April 19, 2013, shall remain in effect until such time as the Temporary Restraining Order is dismissed by the Court after written application of the parties with each party stating its position with respect thereto.


2. The Defendant Thomas E. James shall provide to the Court within 30 days of the date of the hearing an accounting with respect to the receipt or expenditure of funds received by

the Defendants for the purpose of management to produce income for the benefit of the transferor of funds.

3. The Defendant Thomas E. James shall within 30 days of the date of the hearing pay restitution in the total amount of \$66,500.00 to Benethel Renee Lee, 4711 Wirsing Avenue, Fort Smith, Arkansas 72904, with proof of said payment being filed with the Court as evidence thereof.

4. The Defendant Thomas E. James is ordered to not travel outside of the State of Arkansas without written permission from the Court and to not travel more than 200 miles within the State of Arkansas from his home located at 567 East Mimosa Lane, Fayetteville, Arkansas 72703, without written permission from the Court. If Defendant James plans to travel outside of Arkansas or more than 200 miles within Arkansas, a letter requesting approval from the Court should be submitted by his attorney of record.




